

Our Bachelor Programs

Each Bachelor program is divided in sections. The main difference among the sections in each program is defined mostly by the design studios: **LABORATORIO** (Design Studios) and the **WORKSHOPS**, the other courses are mostly the same indifferently from the section. The Design studios from the same program will share the same objectives but they may have a **different topic** to work on.



Our Master Programs

Each Master is divided in sections. For some programs the main difference among the sections is defined by the design studios: **LABORATORIO** (Design Studios) and **WORKSHOPS**.

Other programs are divided into sections according to the language in which courses are held: **ENG** or **ITA**.

Credit System

Each subject is assigned a **number of credits** which the student obtains when he passes the final **examination**.

The **CFU fully coincide with ECTS** credits.






Commitment

Teaching Modalities

The didactic activities in **this academic year 2022-2023** will be offered **in presence**, even though Professors will have the possibility to **set some courses and/or lectures online**. This will depend on the course structure and will be defined by the Professors.

Professors will explain the course structure in the first lesson and the modality to attend the lessons.

Politecnico will ensure the access of the lessons in **presence** in **complete safety**, and in respect with the dispositions defined by the government.

Courses last one semester and are held once per year.

The attendance in the Design studios and workshops is mandatory:

to achieve attendance, it will be necessary to acquire a minimum 80% of attendance

Some monodisciplinary and integrated courses, may be available for non-attending students. Otherwise, the attendance is required as per the Design studios.


